Sub: Recognition Certificate for the school under Child Rights Education Act-2009 and the Karnataka Education Act-1983.

With reference to your application and subsequent school inspection in this regard, I hereby convey the grant of Recognition to Sri Vivekananda Vidya Kendra for class I to X standard for the period 5 years from the academic year 01-Jun-2022 to 31-May- 2027 in compliance to section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education, Act, 2009 & Karnataka State Act-1983.

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid from the academic year 2022-2023 to 2026-2027 and is to be renewed at an interval of every 5 years.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Karnataka State Act-1983.
3. The school shall admit in pre-school/ class I to the extent of 25% of the strength in each class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
4. The school shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of reimbursement.
5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission to any child.
 - a. For lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.



- b. On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The school shall ensure that,-
 - a. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - b. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - c. No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - d. Inclusion of students with disabilities/ special need as per provision of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act.
 - e. The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under RTE Act and its Rules and Karnataka Education Act and its Rules and Government Orders.
 - f. The teachers perform his duties specified under Act Section-24[1] and RTE Act and Rules and Rule-17 of Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
8. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
9. The school shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
10. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
11. The school building plan must have been approved by the current rules or G. Os. The school building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not be carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respect are under whole responsibility of the managements.
12. The school is run by a Trust registered under the Section 10 of the Karnataka Stamp Act.
13. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
14. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared.
15. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
16. Kannada language shall be taught as a subject from in standards 1 to X in all schools notified under Kannada Language Policy 2016 from academic session recognition is granted.

17. The school shall abide by the provisions of the RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
18. The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any stage/ time.
19. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities.
20. The management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to this Deputy Director (Administration), Department of Public Education, Bangalore rural Dist.
21. The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/ Department from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the school.
22. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rule or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.
23. The school management shall have to full responsibility if any court cases arises this regard. The management is not entitled to seek affiliation to other Board without obtaining NOC from the Government of Karnataka Department of Public Education.

Special Note:

1. The guidelines issued regarding the safety measures of the children must be strictly followed and if any damage or violation in this regard is noticed by the management and the school is held responsible.
2. The Management has to compulsory register the school details in the departmental website.
